Rural Municipality of Alexandra, PEI A Bylaw to Establish Municipal Grants Bylaw # 2018-04

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Rural Municipality of Alexandra as follows:

- 1. Title
- 1.1. This bylaw shall be known and cited as the "Grants Bylaw."

2. Authority

Subsection 158(1) of the Municipal Government Act Municipal Government Act 2.1. R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. M-12.1., enables council to provide, by bylaw, for the issuing of grants, including grants for service charges and fees, for any purpose that the council considers to be in the interests of the municipality.

3. Application

3.1. This bylaw applies to Council, municipal staff and any person, group or body for which municipal grants may be established, application may be made, reviewed and awarded.

4. **Definitions**


- 4.1. "Act" means the Municipal Government Act.
- "Chief Administrative Officer" or "CAO" means the administrative head of a 4.2. municipality as appointed by council under subsection 86(2)(c) of the Municipal Government Act.
- "Council" means the Mayor and other members of the Council of the municipality. 4.3.
- "Councillor" means a member of Council other than the Mayor. 4.4.
- "Application" means an application for grant funding as found in Schedule A of this 4.5. Bylaw.
- "Grant" means a sum of money given by the Rural Municipality of Alexandra for a 4.6. specified purpose.
- "Fees" means payments made to the Rural Municipality of Alexandra in exchange 4.7. for services received.
- "Committee of Council" refers to the Council of the Rural Municipality of Alexandra 4.8. as a single Committee.
- "In Kind" means a grant paid by the Rural Municipality of Alexandra in goods, commodities or services instead of money.

5. General

- 5.1. The Rural Municipality of Alexandra establishes under this bylaw a grant program for groups and individuals who offer programs, activities and services in the interest of the municipality or for any purpose that the Council considers to be in the interests of the municipality.
- 5.2. Grants provided by Council are to be identified in the Municipality's budget.

6. Principles

- 6.1. The principles governing grant programs include:
- (a) Council recognizes that, through the provision of grants, Council is committed to providing financial and in-kind assistance to groups and individuals offering services, activities and programs in the interests of the municipality.
- (b) Council is committed to treating requests for grants from these groups in a consistent, fair, and equitable manner, subject to budget.
